As part of our remit at Bury CE Primary to enhance and support inclusivity, we as a staff must ensure we have the tools to support early identification of all needs. We work closely with the Young Carers Team (YCT) as part of West Sussex County Council's Integrated Prevention and Earliest Help (IPEH) Service to endeavour to raise awareness of Young Carers and facilitate appropriate support when it is necessary. As part of this process YCT have supported all staff with training to aid early identification.

'A young carer is a young person under the age of 18 whose life is affected by the care needs of another person, who may have any disability or long-term illness.

This could be anybody with a physical or learning disability, mental health problem, long term chronic health condition, someone who misuses drugs or alcohol, or is elderly and frail.'

At Bury CE Primary Mr Moore is the Young Carers Lead whilst Mrs Seymour is the Young Carers Operational Lead and will oversee signposting information and support.
