Key Vocabulary

bulb	Bulbs grow into new plants.	leaves	Leaves catch sunlight to make energy.
deciduous	A deciduous tree loses its leaves each year.	petals	Petals are the colourful part of the flower
evergreen	An evergreen tree keeps its green leaves all year round, even in the winter.	roots	Roots take in water and nutrients from the soil.
flowers	Flowers are usually colourful and attract insects and birds.	seed	Seeds grow into new plants
fruit	Fruit contains the plant's seeds.	stem	The stem holds the plant up and carries the water and nutrients from the roots to the leaves and flowers.

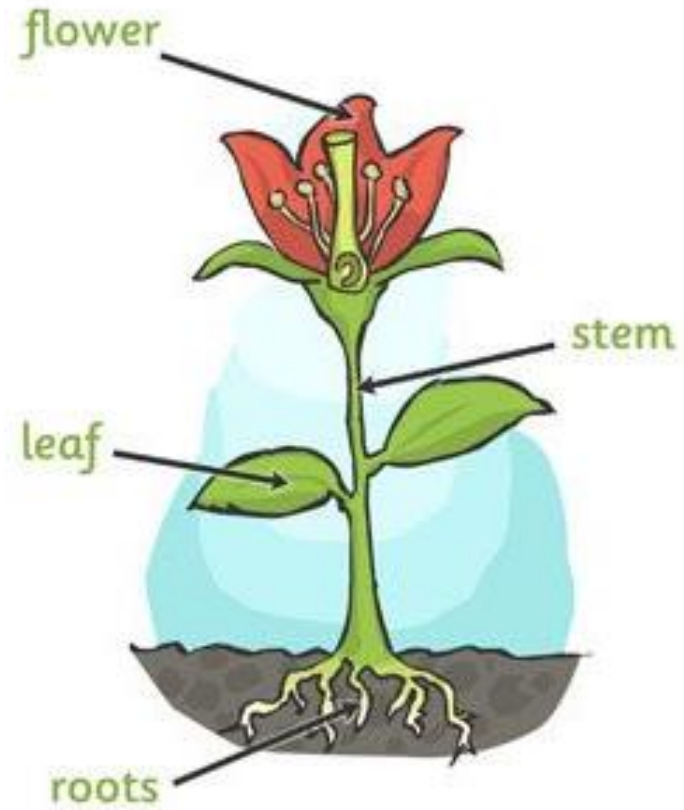
