Christian	A person who has received Christian baptism or is a believer in Christianity.	resurrection	The rising of Christ from the dead

Key Facts

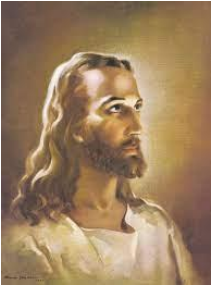
Pentecost is the festival when Christians celebrate the gift of the Holy Spirit. It is celebrated on the Sunday 50 days after Easter.

Pentecost is regarded as the birthday of the Christian church, and the start of the church's mission to the world.

Pentecost is a Christian holiday, observed on the seventh Sunday after Easter, that celebrates the blessing of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other followers of Jesus Christ as mentioned in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 2:1-31).

The day of Pentecost is known in the Christian Church as the day on which the Spirit descended upon the apostles, and under Peter's preaching, so many thousands were converted in Jerusalem.

Key People



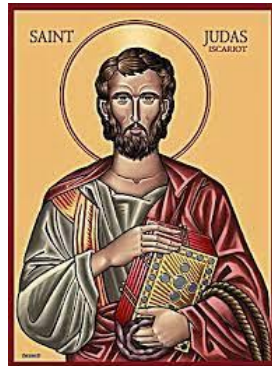
Jesus, also referred to as Jesus of Nazareth or Jesus Christ, was a first-century Jewish preacher and religious leader.



Mary was a 1st century Galilean Jewish woman of Nazareth, the wife of Joseph and the mother of Jesus.

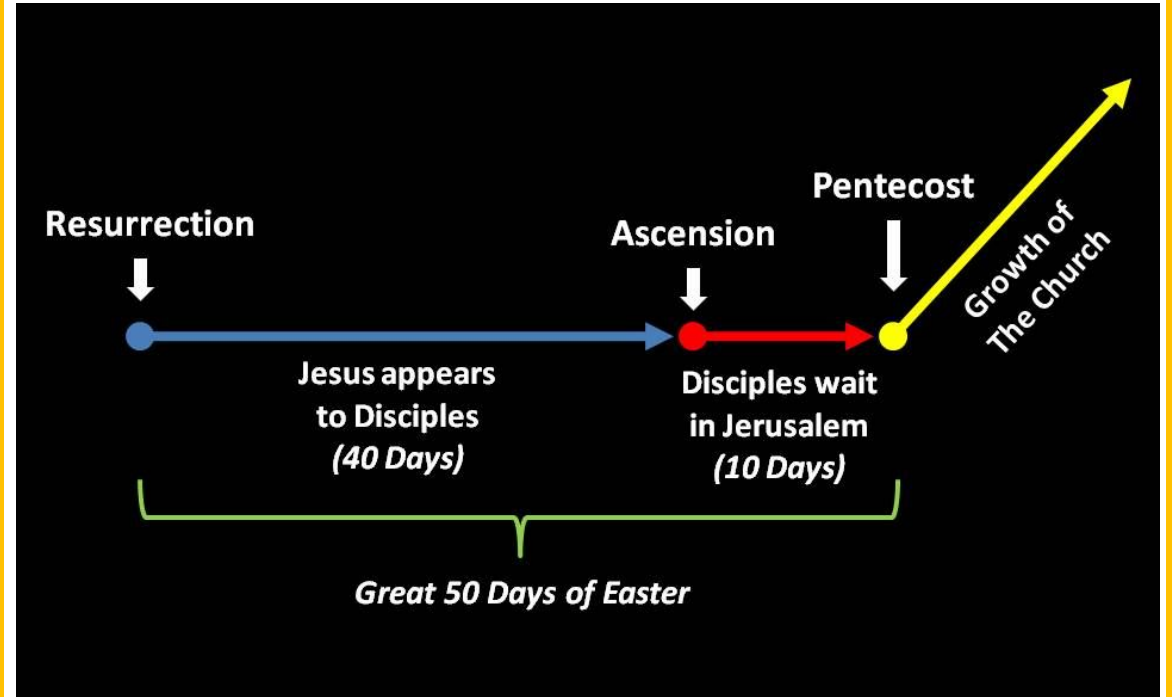


Saint Matthias, the disciple who was chosen to replace Judas Iscariot after Judas betrayed Jesus.
