Gunpowder Plot	Robert Catesby led the Gunpowder Plot to blow up the Houses of Parliament to kill King James I.
Guy Fawkes	He had to guard the 36 barrels of gunpowder in the cellar of the Houses of Parliament.
Houses of Parliament	A special building in London where lots of meetings and rules are set up.
poppy	People wear poppies to remember the people that died. The poppy was the first flower to grow in the fields when the fighting had stopped.
Remembrance day	Every year before and on 11 th November we wear poppies to show that we remember all of the people that lost their lives during wars. A two minute silence is held as a sign of respect.

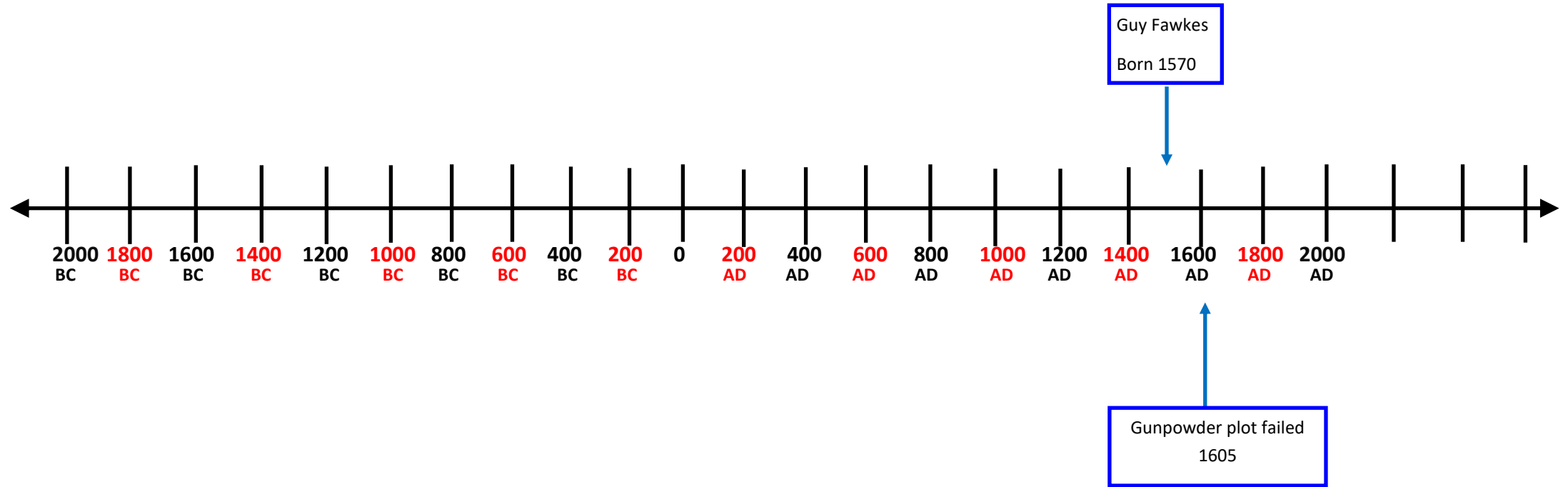
Key Facts

The Gunpowder Plot happened in 1605 and there were 13 people involved in the plot. However it failed as Guy Fawkes was found in the cellar of the Houses of Parliament before he lit the gunpowder.
