Key People

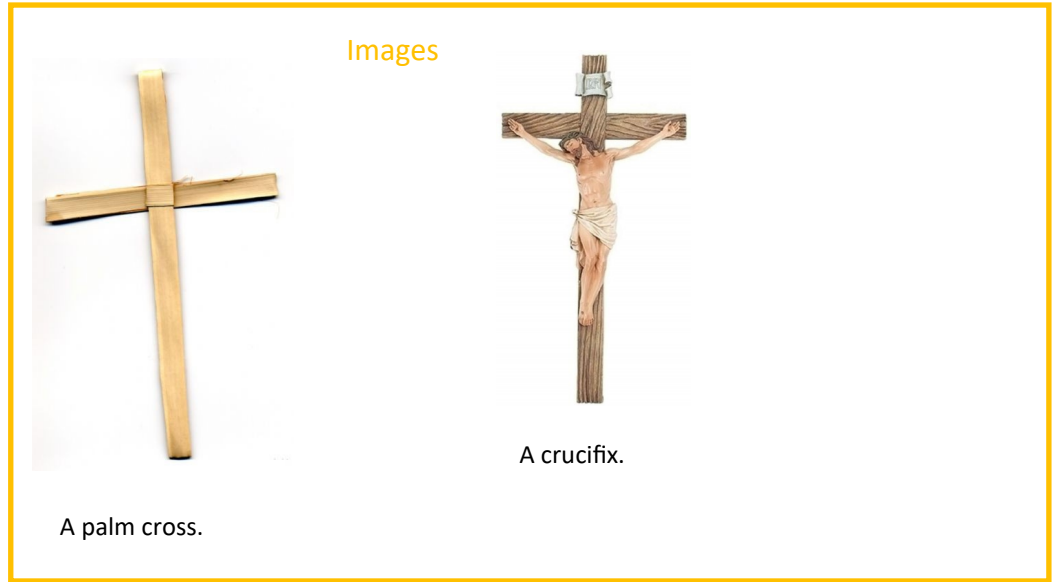
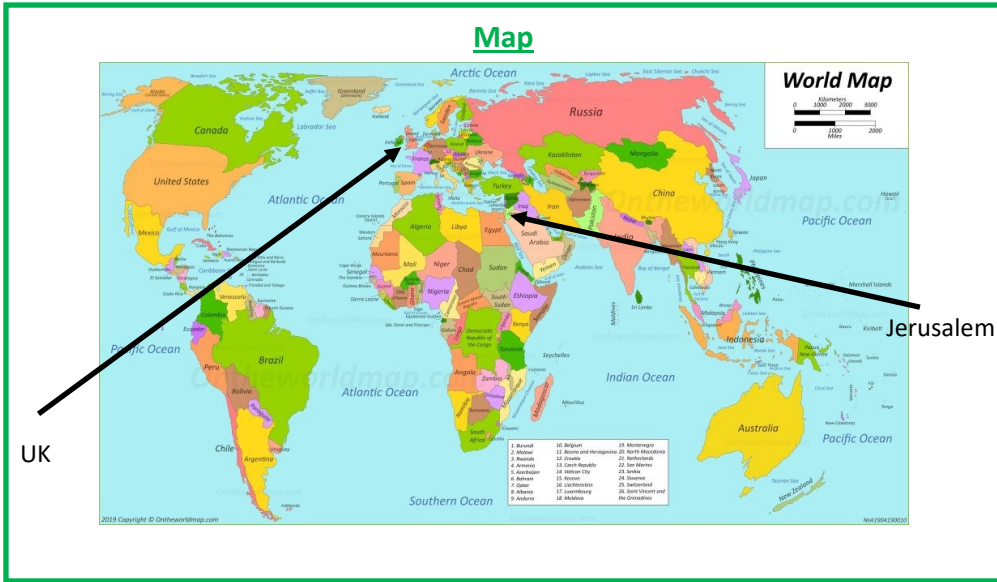
Mary was the mother of Jesus. She supported Jesus in his final moments and discovered his empty tomb on the day of his resurrection.

Easter is known as the weekend from Good Friday to Easter Monday. It celebrates the resurrection of Christ.

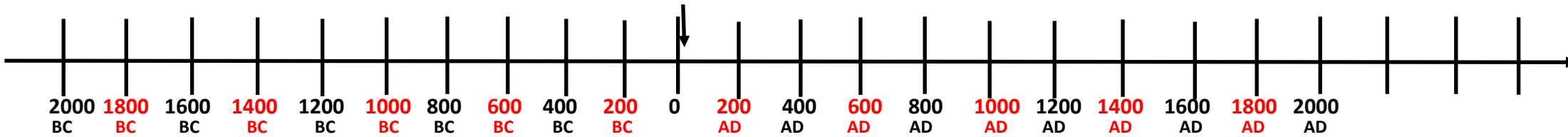
Palm crosses are used to celebrate Palm Sunday. This is the day that Jesus entered Jerusalem, when palm branches were placed in his path.
