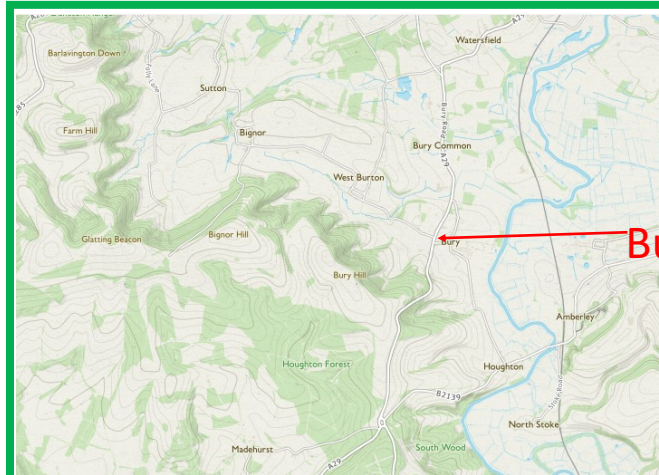
## Key Vocabulary

Bury School was built in 1844.

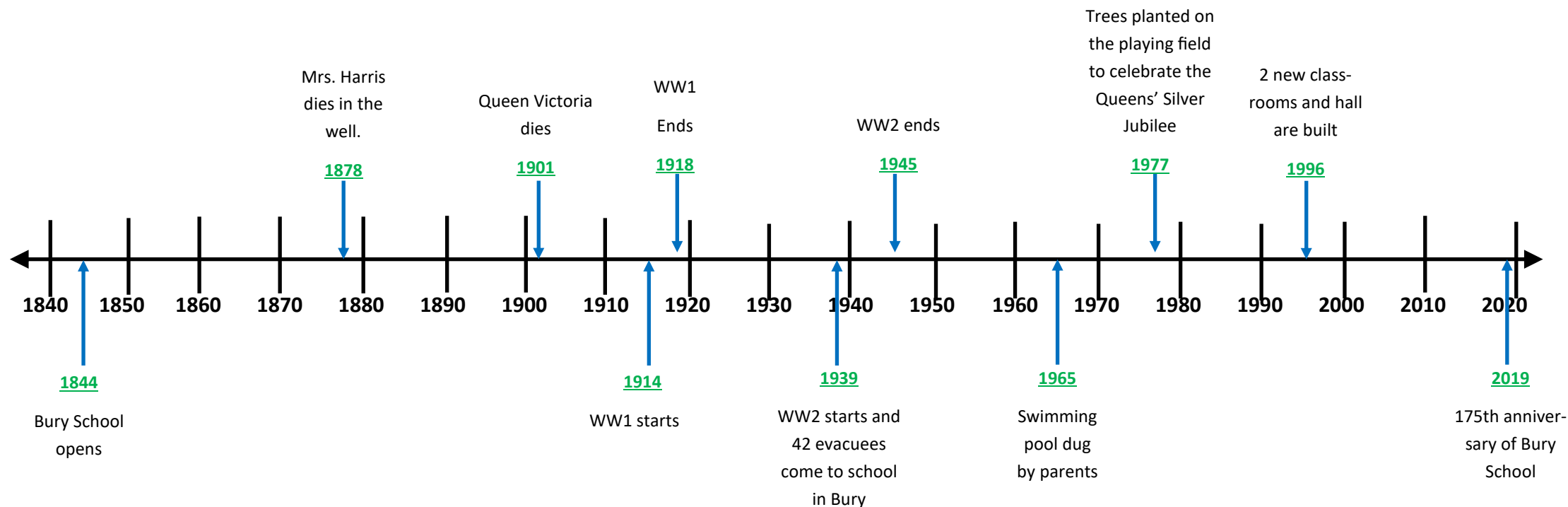
Bury school has always has between 40 and 60 pupils, except during WW2 when there were about 70 pupils.
