



Key Facts

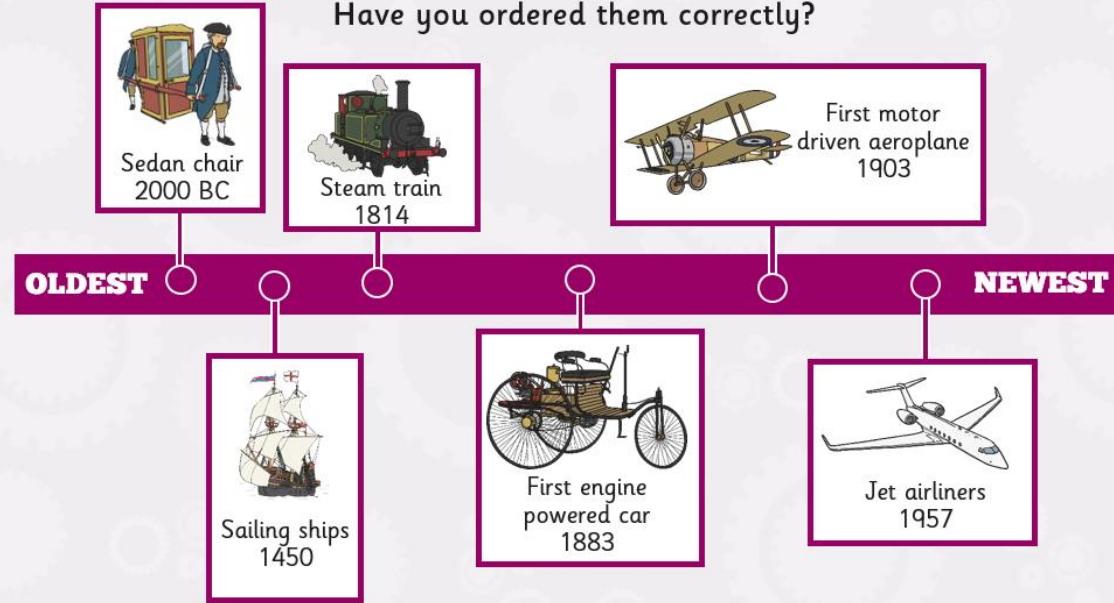
